How about a review of your church payables (purchase invoices) to ascertain if the church has paid Ohio sales tax in error? You undoubtedly are aware that the church is entitled to a sales tax exemption, but you may be surprised at what you are unknowingly paying in such taxes.

Two Ohio Department of Taxation Audit Managers (retired) are offering a free review of your church records and assistance in filing a refund claim for any Ohio sales tax paid in error. Please do not assume you are not paying such taxes. Every church which has undergone a review has had a refund claim filed on their behalf.

There is 62+ years of tax auditing experience available to assist you. There is absolutely no fee or service charge for these reviews. References are available should you have any concern about someone from outside your immediate church viewing your records. The review takes place in your church and your only "cost" is a small investment of staff time to present the appropriate records and copying of any invoices subject to refund.

Your questions on future purchases will also be addressed.

As this is a "Free" review, there may be some limitation on the distance to be traveled by the reviewers. However, it doesn't hurt to ask, so contact the individual noted and schedule your review.

Why is this being offered? Based upon experience it is known that churches receive very little assistance from the auditing/accounting sector and simply put, we are looking to fill some long winter days. 😊
