This course is the foundation for all other learning and lay leadership courses where you are encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended. Participants are invited to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in their discipleship. The course offers guidelines for best practices as a church leader in mission and ministry in the community and in daily life. A pastoral letter of recommendation reflecting the support of the church council should be sent to the district office for any first-time application to take the Basic Lay Servant course. Upon completion of the Basic Lay Servant course, a lay servant may be recognized by the charge conference as a Local Church Lay Servant, meaning he or she may serve the local church in witnessing to the Christian faith through spoken communication, church and community leadership, and care-giving ministries.
